The University of Cape Town's Faculty for Engineering and the Built Environment has offered a Master in Philosophy (Conservation of the Built Environment) degree since 2009; and I convene that programme.

I have learned of the proposed post-graduate diploma programme being developed by the SA Institute for Heritage Science and Conservation by way of the interactions we have each year when lecturers of that Institute present a lecture in the Masters degree programme referred to above.
