INCLUDED IN TUITION FEES*

TUITION FEES INCLUDE:

Scheduled course tuition and academic, technical & administrative support rendered by staff.

Use of the Institute's technical equipment and materials, as identified by the faculty staff, and essential for the completion of the programme (exceptions being fax; copier; print & binding services).

Programme related orientation activities.

Academic textbook bundle (loan set or purchase set - at their respective costs - as per student's preference)

Access to the Institute's networked media room during 3rd trimester – in support of dissertation research.

Internet WiFi connection. (Regular student housing units offer uncapped internet access - custom housing arrangements might not.)

Access to the Institute's physical library of volumes, permitting volumes to be relocated to the reading room upon request.

Use of the Institute's campus and facility resources for scheduled activities and learning support.

Certain miscellaneous provisions, including one, white laboratory overcoat, issued at the inception of the 1st trimester.

Programme assessment, awards and graduation function. (External examination fee of dissertation excepted)
